

Park History

Pet Owners Organization of Citrus Heights (P.O.O.C.H.) was incorporated in 1997 to develop an off-leash dog park. In partnership with Sunrise Recreation and Parks District, the area at C Bar C was opened in October, 2000.

The two organizations work together to maintain and upgrade the park area.

In October 2005, we opened "Buddy's Park" for small dogs in memory of Buddy, a Boston Terrier.

P.O.O.C.H. members, with their dues and donations, pay for improvements to the park, dog waste bags and insurance for special events. Membership Dues are paid on a calendar year basis from January to December.

There is no charge for use of the park.

P.O.O.C.H. Park is accessible for those with special needs.

The park is open everyday from dawn to dusk with the exception of time for mowing and maintenance by the Sunrise Recreation & Parks District.

Even though your dog may just be greeting, the new dog doesn't know that and can very quickly become overwhelmed from several dogs rushing in.
